

SPECIAL NEEDS POLICY/PROCEDURE

The parachute club is aware that some children have special educational needs and disabilities that may require particular support and assistance and recognise a wide range of needs, learning difficulties, emotional, social behaviour and physical difficulties.

The parachute club is committed to the inclusion of children with special educational needs and disabilities giving them there right to play, learn and to be able to develop to their full potential alongside other children.

All children have the right to learn together and develop relationships, whenever possible children with special needs or disabilities will have access to the same facilities, activities and opportunities as others.

When providing for the needs of children, it is vital to work closely with parents and carers. All information should be logged and all form completed prior to a child starting club.

The parachute club will also seek advice of the Bolton SEN/Disability development and support officer, when needed
